Enrolment figures taken at 9 March 2015 were used to calculate the revised electoral district and region boundaries. These came into effect at the 2017 State general election.

Large districts (100,000 km² or greater) qualify for a Large District Allowance (LDA) when electoral boundaries are drawn.

The LDA is calculated by multiplying the square kilometres of the district by 1.5%. The final number, calculated by adding the allowance to the number of electors in the district, must be within a range of 20% less or 10% greater than the average district enrolment.

The impact of the LDA on the variation from average district enrolment is shown in the Enrolment Electoral District Quota report for the Mining and Pastoral and Agricultural regions.
